BirdBuffer Q2 Installation Steps



Wind Direction: a photo of the area birds are located with someone pointing the wind direction, helps for best position.

Bird Location: not where they sit but where they fly. We want the vapor to cover the entire area they fly in. If they don't fly, ask them nicely to fly.

Hanging or Mounting: Easiest position is to hang the unit from the ceiling or truss.

If you decide to mount it to the wall, you will need to order a bracket or make one.



Easy too!

Easy-to-hang-cables included when requested. Just clip the snaphooks to the extended legs.

Mount bracket: Just bolt it to the wall and point it in the direction the wind is blowing. Mount high yet easy to service from a ladder. Set the timer, bolt it on and plug it in.



Reversible Bracket: For higher or lower mounting, just turn it over. P/N 820062
